MISCELLANEOUS ACTION ITEMS: The following items were discussed, and possible action taken.

- a. Recreational Grant Application. Discuss and possible approval of how the Town can use the grant. James Beno reviewed the grant and what will be considered for approval, all grants submitted must have something to do with recreation. The grant is for a 30/70 split with the Town and needs to be spent by end of 2027. Jim shared the needs of the pickleball courts, higher fence on one side and second entrance. Lake boat launches were discussed. Lake John Road boat launch is always getting washed out and guys are repairing that a lot, blacktop would stop that from happening. Wheeler Lake and Waubee Lake launches need repairs from power loading and another cement slab for when lakes are low, Jamie B. also mentioned that something needs to be done with the "V" that was created and run off. Mike M. received reasonable quotes on slabs, they would be poured and cured outside the lake and installed. After long discussion, it was decided to check the quote on the cement slabs and blacktop for Lake John access and Jim would complete the grant application based on those quotes and add to the 2027 budget.
